



1 Ticket Buyer – Strikethrough + N/A: name of purchaser or name on card used to place order.

Reserved by: name of the buyer. Used as a placeholder and always matches a name with a strikethrough.

Tickets are not held under this name. Tickets under "Reserved as" name. In this case, Montgomery, Scotty.

2 Attendee – Ticket Number + Quantity: name of person attending event and number of tickets they have.

Reserved as: name of the attendee. Used as a placeholder and always matches a name with a strikethrough.

Montgomery, Scotty has one ticket reserved under their name that Captain Kirk purchased.
